



School of Leadership & Management Excellence 2017 Scholarship Application

Purpose

The Catholic Cemetery Conference *School of Leadership and Management Excellence* Scholarship helps Catholic cemeterians currently employed by Catholic Cemeteries. The Scholarship is intended to help pay tuition costs related to continuing education at the CCC *School of Leadership & Management Excellence* at the University of Notre Dame.

Eligibility

Any employee of an affiliated Catholic Cemetery that is a member of the Conference, is eligible to apply for a CCC Scholarship, provided the applicant has been continuously employed by the respective Catholic Cemetery for at least one year. Applications must be approved by the applicant's employer.

Scholarships

Each year the CCC Board of Directors will make CCC Scholarships available for full tuition and on-campus housing. A maximum of two (2) scholarships will be available in any given year.

The individual scholarships will be based on demonstrated need, as well as what changes the individual hopes to gain from the CCC curriculum. Scholarships will be awarded each year one month prior to the annual *School of Leadership and Management Excellence*. Applications shall be due at the CCC National Office at least five weeks before the annual school. Application forms can be found on CCC's website: catholiccemeteryconference.org or from the CCC National Office. Scholarships will be payable upon proof of enrollment.



School of Leadership & Management Excellence

Criteria

- Catholic Cemetery Conference (CCC) Scholarships are available to any employee of an affiliated Catholic Cemetery that is a member of the Conference, based on financial need.
- Scholarships are intended to help pay costs directly related to the applicant's continuing education and the CCC School of Leadership & Management Excellence.
- Applicant must have been an employee of the respective member Catholic Cemetery for at least one (1) year.
- Applications must be approved by the applicant's employer
- The amount of each scholarship will be for full tuition.
- A maximum of two (2) scholarships will be available in any given year and will be determined by the CCC Board of Directors.
- No applicant shall receive more than two scholarships from the CCC Scholarship program.
- No applicant may apply for a second scholarship without providing proof of successful completion of schools for which the first scholarship was awarded.
- Scholarships for the following CCC school year will be awarded each year one month prior to the annual School of Leadership and Management Excellence. Scholarship applications must be received at the CCC National Office no later than five (5) weeks before the annual school. Applications for the year 2017 scholarship must be received at the CCC National Office by April 28, 2017.
- Scholarship will be reimbursed to applicant only upon proof of tuition payment by applicant to CCC.
- Any tax liabilities are the sole responsibility of the scholarship recipient.
